**[1]** From the car park, walk on the Pontcharal Lake dyke. You will notice down below the old dyke of the pond of abbey monks, ripped open during the Revolution by the angry inhabitants. Take the path on the other side of the road (D7).

**[2]** Walk up to the village of *Commagnac*. To let you know, every word ending by *-ac* has a Gallo-Roman origin. When you arrive in the village, continue straight on the road.

**[3]** At the crossroad, take the path in front of you. At about 200m, follow the path on the left overhanging the “*Brezou*”. This stream takes its source in the lake of Seilhac and flows into the Vezere in front of the village of *Viallevaleix*.

**[4]** After the pine forest, on the right, this path leads to the stream, at the place-called “*Le Moulin de la Forêt*”.

**[5]** Once you crossed the “*Brezou*”, at the crossroads, walk up to the right.

**[6]** Before you reach the first houses of the “*Buginie*”, take the large path going down to the “*Brezou*” at the “*Moulin de la Forge*”.

**[7]** Cross the bridge and walk up to the path until you reach “*Commagnac*”. Then, turn back and take the same path to the Pontcharal Lake. This lake is 15 hectares wide and has been inaugurated in 1972. During the fitting up, the inhabitants of Vigeois have planted their tree extracted from the neighbouring forest or offered by a personality.

**[8]** The D7 crossed, take on your right the path along the lake through the patios and the timbers.

**[9]** At the lake end, cross a small wooden bridge spanning the stream of “*Le Pont Lagorce*” that feeds the lake.

**[10]** The path continue until you reach the camping and the beach.
